

RHC proposal going forward

- LEGAL
 - Early advice from multiple jurisdictions have found that the RHC concept WILL offend competition laws.
 - Advice indicates that it would be difficult to find a suitable change to the concept for the RHC to proceed.
 - All of the advice to date, indicates that RHC represents a complex legal challenge to proceed.
 - A comprehensive submission of legal opinion will be provided by the WTAAA in the coming months.

- SAFER SELLING CONCEPT – Purpose to capture “bust outs”
 - Actively pursue the implantation of Real Time reporting.
 - Once real time reporting can be implemented, then a pilot should be run
 - Proposal to use the 100% formula as agreed during the RHC working group process
 - Results to be reported back.
 - Rules to be developed and put into resolution 8xx Section 5 (Safer Selling), whereby the Agency Administrator could invoke Reso 818g, 13.2 to suspend ticketing will need to be incorporated into Reso 8xx Section 5.
 - Limits to be agreed at the APJC level
 - Amend Reso 890 1.4 to allow for consent for agents use of own card
